

This year in Sydney, Navratri and Dussera will occur over a 9-day period, instead of the usual 10-days. This is because, on Day 3 (29/9) the worship of both, Chandraghanta Devi and Kushmanda Devi fall on the same day according to the lunar calendar.

The festival will be accessible to devotees in both, online and face-to-face formats, allowing plenty of opportunities for all spiritual seekers to join in on the divine fun.

The practice of Śri Vidya rituals (such as those being performed this Navratri) radiates auspiciousness to all seekers. Blessings include spiritual upliftment and inner purification among many others.
